

Officer Patino Statement

OFF. PATINO: Alright. (*Reading*) Early in the morning on January 6, 2017, Officer Kenney Cha and I responded to a call regarding a violation of a restraining order. While attempting to discuss the matter with the suspect, he became irate, aggressive, and violent towards us. During the encounter, the suspect, who was a large man, made numerous threats of violence. At one point he charged at us and Officer Cha pepper sprayed him. He charged at us again a second time engaged in a violent, physical attack. I had to pull my baton in self-defense but that did not stop the suspect. He attacked me by reaching for the baton, assaulted me by punching me in the face, and knocked me down a flight of stairs onto the sidewalk. I then heard at least two gunshots go off.

Officer Cha Statement

Ok. (*Reading*) Early in the morning on January 6, 2017, Officer Colin Patino and I responded to a call regarding a violation of a restraining order. While attempting to discuss the matter with the suspect, he became irate, aggressive, and violent. During the encounter, the suspect, who was a large man, made numerous threats of violence. At one point charged at us, and I used pepper spray. He charged at us a second time and engaged in a violent physical attack. He assaulted Officer Patino by punching him and kicking him in the face and knocking him down the flight of stairs. The suspect continued charging. I shot the suspect two times with my firearm in order to defend myself and my partner from serious bodily harm or death.
